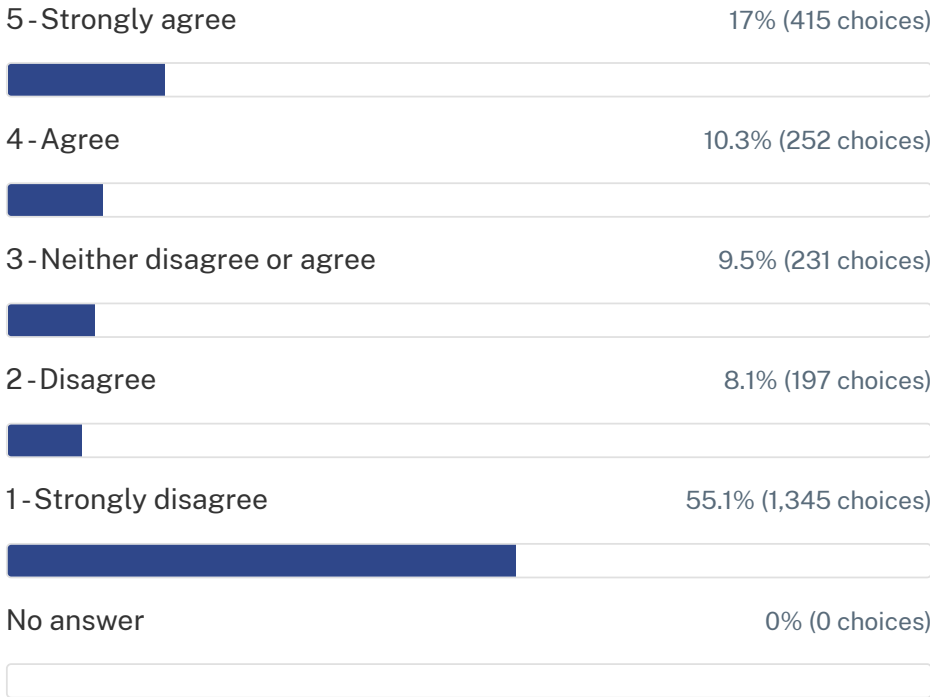

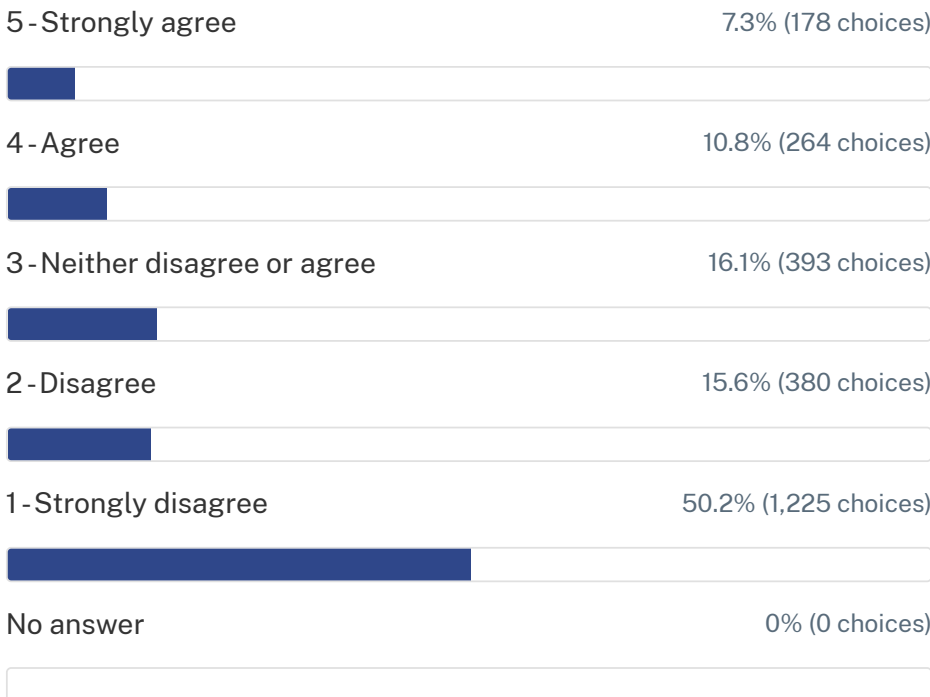
## How much do you support the model proposed in "option B"?

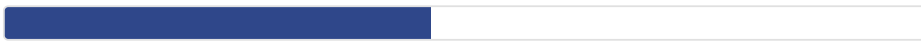

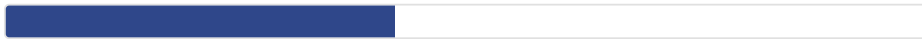
# Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?

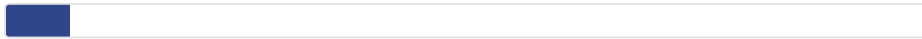

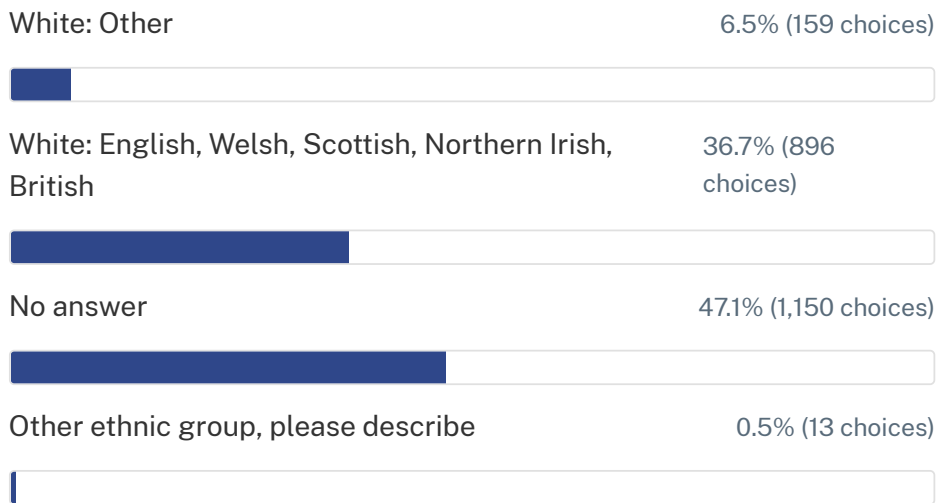

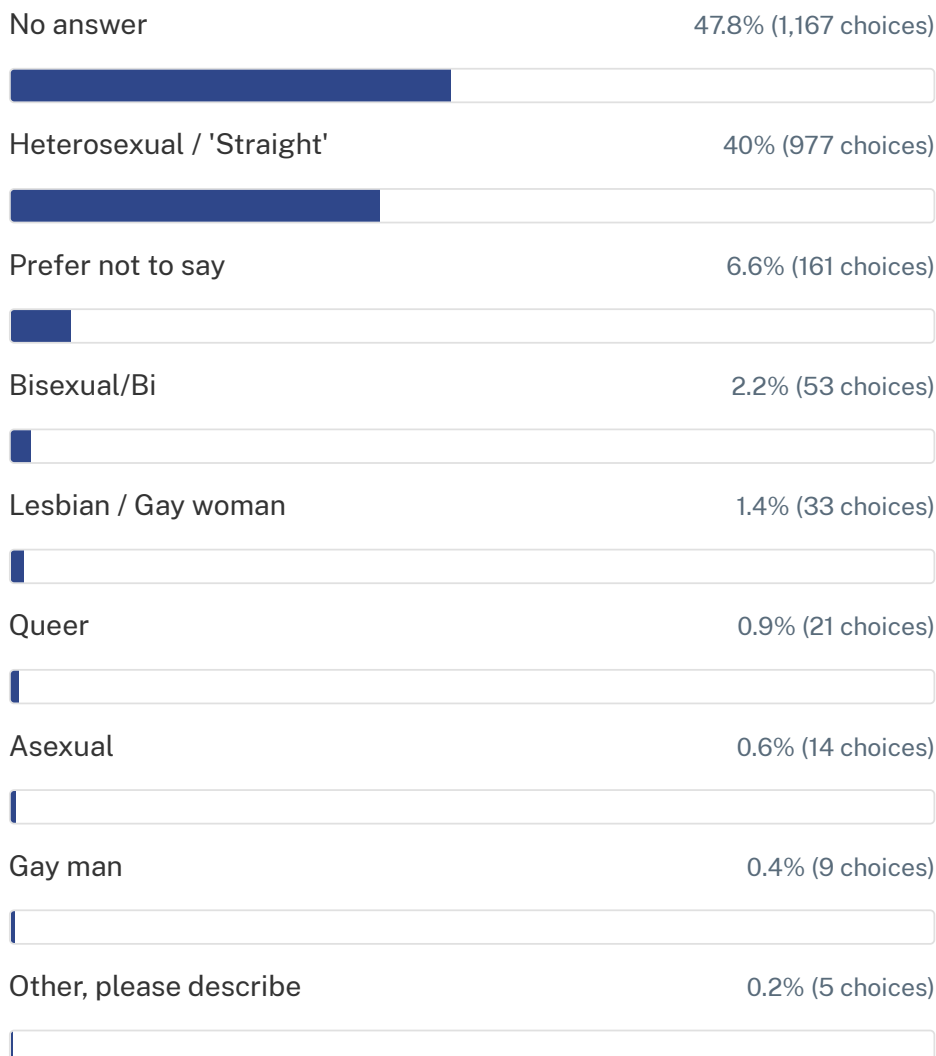
